

# How to Replace Your ID in Atlanta

If you are in Atlanta and need to replace your identification, this document will provide information on where to go and what you will need when you get there. In addition to needing ID for employment and various services, you'll need the items on this list in order to be placed in the Atlanta housing queue. If you need to replace all of your identification, follow the list in order. *Each location address lists the nearest MARTA location.*

## Proof of Residency (Mailing Address) and Birth Certificate

<p><b>WHAT YOU NEED:</b> If you are living on the street, you will ask for a HOMELESS VERIFICATION LETTER and a BIRTH CERTIFICATE. The letter will provide you with a mailing address you can use for all documentation. To get your birth certificate your date of birth, location of birth, full name at birth, social security number, and parents' names may be required. Depending on where you were born, you may be required to provide additional information.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Central Outreach operates on a first-come, first-served basis. It is best to get there a few minutes before they open as there is usually a line. OAC offers other services as well, so ask while you're there.</p>	

## TB Test / Medical Record

Fulton County Public Health Clinic 10 Park Place South SE <i>(4 minutes from Five Points station)</i>	Monday - Friday 8:30am - 5:00pm
<p><b>NOTE:</b> The TB test will require TWO VISITS. You will need to go back to have the results read in no more than 3 days, or you will have to do the test again. This test serves two purposes: You need a TB test to be considered for housing, but it also establishes a medical record if you don't already have one. You need a medical record to get other documents in this list, and a completed TB test will qualify.</p>	

## Georgia Voter ID Card

**NOTE:** In order to receive a voter ID card, you must not currently be on probation or parole. If you are, see the NOTE under Social Security Card, below.

## Social Security Card

**WHAT YOU NEED:** You may be able to request a replacement card online. Register for an account at <https://www.ssa.gov/signin> and try before going to the office. If you go, take your PROOF OF RESIDENCE, MEDICAL RECORD, and VOTER ID CARD. These documents will provide the proof necessary to replace your social security card.

Your card will be mailed to you, so you should ask for a STATEMENT ON LETTERHEAD before you leave the office

**NOTE:** If you have been convicted of a felony and are on parole or probation, a copy of your incarceration printout that includes your photo may work to verify your identity at the Social Security Office, provided the printout is signed by a corrections officer and it includes your social security number.

## Georgia Driver License or State ID

<b>WHAT YOU NEED:</b> Take your PROOF OF RESIDENCE, VOTER ID CARD and SOCIAL SECURITY CARD.  If you have a current Georgia license or state ID but have lost it, you may be able to get a replacement copy at no charge by completing a Change of Address request on the website ( <a href="http://dds.georgia.gov">dds.georgia.gov</a> ).  <b>NOTE:</b> Your ID card will be mailed to you, but you will receive a temporary ID in the form of a printed page. This temporary ID will be valid for 120 days.	

## Wage Inquiry Printout

<b>NOTE:</b> This is a basic printout of your reported wages (income). It should be stamped with a seal that says “Georgia Department of Labor”.	

## HUD McKinney Form

Grady Behavioral Health Center 10 Park Place South SE (4 minutes from Five Points station)	Monday - Friday: 8:00 am - 2:00 pm
The Department of Housing and Urban Development’s (HUD) McKinney-Vento program provides housing support for people experiencing homelessness. This form is completed by a licensed medical professional to determine your qualification for this program. If you are seen by a medical doctor or psychiatrist, ask them to complete the form. If not, go to the address above and tell them you need a HUD McKinney form.
